Description of the host organization and foreseen activities

The Centre for Sustainable Environmental Sanitation (CSES) is part of the Department of Environmental Engineering at the University of Science and Technology, Beijing, China. The centre was created in 2007 with the objective of building capacity in the sectors of sustainable environmental sanitation, food security, bioenergy and climate protection. CSES hosts the Global Alliance for Productive Biogas and participates in a number of international collaborations. Students enrolled in the programme, from China and other countries, acquire theoretical qualifications and gain practical experiences. During an internship, they work in international teams with experts from a wide range of disciplines.

The tasks of this project offer a very high professional learning potential. Together with your GLEN partners and other enrolled students, you will participate in a four week preparation programme in Beijing, starting at the beginning of July. Afterwards, you will conduct a two month internship, possibly at a CSES partner institution in another country. If you choose to stay in Funyang and Beijing, China, you can support research on upgrading biogas to biomethane and test prefabricated biogas plants. If you want, you can join a partner institution in Lesotho or Samoa after the four weeks of thematic introduction. There, you would participate in monitoring the conversion of biogas to electricity. An international driving license is required for this project. You can also continue the biogas sanitation study in Tokelau. Transport costs are covered by the project. However, participants are requested to bring their own laptop.

The GLEN team will be formed by two German and a Hungarian participant.
